# A brief story of Vishnu's Avatar "Sri Krishna" followed by a quiz

Unlike Shri Ram, a greatly revered Avatar of the previous Yuga, Krishna was fully conscious of his divinity and he never tried to hide his divine prowess. It is impossible to abridge Sri Krishna's life in a few paragraphs, but here is an outline of his life followed by a Quiz, compiled by Jai Viswanathan which he used during Hindu Satsang's Janmashtami Program.

A sage had forewarned the egoistic and evil King Kans, that he would be killed by his sister Devaki's 8th child. So Kans imprisoned Devaki and Vasudev so that he can have each child murdered right in front of him, as soon as they were born. Devaki, and her husband Vasudev, were able to sneak the 8th child out of the prison to safety. This child was Sri Krishna. Krishna was raised by foster parents Yashoda and Nand in Gokul at the banks of the river Yamuna. Kans sent many demons to kill Krishna, but all of them failed. Krishna returned to Mathura and killed Kans, restoring dharma to the land.

Krishna refused to bear arms in the great war between the adharmic Kauravas (sons of Dhritarashtra, the descendant of Kuru) and the dharmic Pandavas (sons of Pandu), but he offered a choice of himself to one side and his army to the other. The Pandavas chose Sri Krishna, and he thus served as charioteer for Arjuna, one of the Pandav brothers. Sri Krishna's advice to Arjuna in the battlefield - the 700 verses of 'The Bhagavad Gita', formed the centerpiece of Mahabharata. It is the 'Gita' that stands as Krishna's most important gift to the world. The Gita delivers the essence of spirituality in a way that a common man can understand. The war ended with the annihilation of Kauravas and the rule of the Pandavas was established.

Finally, when Sri Krishna decided that it was his time to stop his divine plays in his present Avatar, he retired to the forest and engaged himself in deep meditation. He was slain by an arrow which was mistakenly aimed at his foot by a hunter who thought it was a deer. Soon a great tsunami came and the surging sea waters submerged the entire city of Dwaraka.

In 'The Bhagavad Gita', Sri Krishna predominantly teaches Karma Yoga – the path of attaining the greatest goal of life through selfless action by surrendering all the fruits of actions at the feet of the lord. In Bhagavad Gita, he also elaborates the other spiritual paths like 'Bhakti Yoga' and 'Gyana Yoga'.
